9. MATTERS ARISING / UNRHYW FATER ARALL

9.1 It was resolved to retrospectively increase the allocated funding for the "party in the Square" from £500.00 to £633.47. An increase of £133.47 to cover the over spend.

- 9.2 It was resolved to provide retrospective permission for the provision of a letter of support from the Llandovery Town Council for a Lottery Funding Application by the YMCA.
- 9.3 Cllr N. Burgess delivered a report from the Area Meeting of One Voice Wales and this is attached to these minutes.
- 9.4 It was reported that to date, no report had been received from the Council Solicitors regarding the draft Pantycelyn lease.
- 9.5 A proposal to dress the main areas of the Town in flags/bunting from May through September of each year was not carried.
- 9.6 It was resolved to allow a cheque that has been wrongly addressed to the Town Council to pass through the Council Accounts. It was reported that the cheque (£600) should have been made out to the Lights Committee and was inadvertently addressed to the Town Council.

10. ACCOUNTS / CYFRIFON

- 10.1. It was resolved to approve the schedule from the Town Clerk relating to income totalling £8,336.11 and payments totalling £4,368.14 for the period 1 to 30 June 2016.
- 10.2. The Consolidated Statement of Accounts and the Budget Summary as at 30 June 2016 was noted.
- 10.3. The Responsible Financial Officer's Report for July 2016 was received and noted
- 10.4. It was resolved to approve the accounting statements and Annual Governance Statement on the Council's completed Annual Return for the year ended 31 March 2016 following the Internal Audit, and to authorise the Clerk to send the Annual Return to the External Auditor.
- 10.5. It was resolved to approve the proposed adjustments to the Budget for 2016-17 from 1 July 2016 outlined in the RFO Report less Item 3 (Hub 4 (Cleaning) which is due to be reviewed at Sub-Committee level.

- 11.1 It was resolved to send a cheque for £50 in response to a non-specific request for funding from URDD
- 11.2 A request for funding from St John (Cymru) was tabled.
- 11.3 It was resolved to donate £500 in response to a non-specific request from Llandovery Fireworks Committee to fund the Llandovery Fireworks Display.
- 11.4 A proposal to ratify a donation of £500 to the Llandovery Sheep Festival was deferred due to the Council not having received a Statement of Accounts as requested in June.

- 12.1 A letter of thanks from Caitlin Morgan for the donation of £100 towards her Malaysia Volunteering Project was noted

13. REGENERATION - ACTION POINTS

- 13.1 A report was received listing some of the most dilapidated buildings in the main areas of the Town. It was resolved to encourage owners to continue to improve the appearance of their properties. A list of properties requiring action will be submitted to Carmarthenshire County Council for possible Enforcement Action.
- 13.2 It was resolved that the Council would pursue the matter of the dangerous wall and the Concrete Blocks opposite Mile End House on Broad Street with both SWTRA and, the County Council Enforcement Officers.


